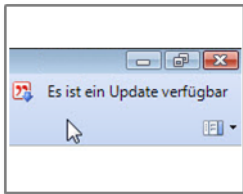

Free Update for Citavi 3.1.15 Now Available



We've just released a free update with a lot of new features. For one, the Picker for Firefox now supports Firefox 7. In addition, Citavi now optimizes access to projects on slow network connections, letting you work more quickly. And, if you use Citavi with Parallels on a Mac, you'll notice that Citavi starts much faster in Coherence mode. A complete list of the changes in 3.1.15 is available at www.citavi.com/update.

How can you update to Citavi 3.1.15? When you open a Citavi project, Citavi will let you know that an update is available (as long as you're connected to the Internet). Click *An update is available* and follow the steps in the setup assistant. Alternatively, you can download the latest version of Citavi at www.citavi.com/download.

With Citavi 3.1.15, it's now possible to extend Citavi with Add-Ons. Add-Ons let you use the special features you need without overloading Citavi for users who have no use for them.

During our 2½ years of work on Citavi for Mac, we invested a lot of time, creativity, and money to try to develop the best product possible. Ultimately we decided on a technical platform that we now consider to have an uncertain future. Because of this, we no longer see a way to meet our goals for Citavi for Mac in a way which would ensure its continued existence. We are truly sorry to have to disappoint you after such a long wait.

So will Mac users never have the opportunity to use Citavi? No. For now, virtualization continues to be a good option, especially Parallels Desktop and VMware Fusion. We're going to concentrate on finishing Citavi 4, which will contain important and frequently requested features. After that, we plan to... no, we're not going to do that! We shared too much, too early, about the development of Citavi for Mac and set expectations that we now cannot meet. We're going to do it right this time by waiting until after the release of Citavi 4 to let you know what's coming next.
